Abukloi Secondary School Launches Academic Year 2024 with Anticipation and Increased Enrollment.



Rumbek, Lakes State, January 22, 2024 - Abukloi Secondary School in Lakes State, Rumbek, officially commenced the new academic year on January 22, 2024. Mr. Joseph Mangar, the Director of Studies, announced that continuing students will promptly receive their report cards, with a total of 351 students promoted from Senior 1, Senior 2, and Senior 3.

The registration process for Senior 2, Senior 3, and Senior 4 begins immediately after students receive their report cards. Additionally, registration for Senior 1 students will commence as soon as the primary eight results are announced by the National Ministry of Education.

In terms of vacancies, Abukloi Secondary School is offering 300 slots for Form 1 students. Mr. Joseph expressed the school's ambition to enroll a total of 700 students this year, reflecting a growth from the 667 enrolled in the previous academic year of 2023. The school is poised for a dynamic and promising educational journey in the coming months
